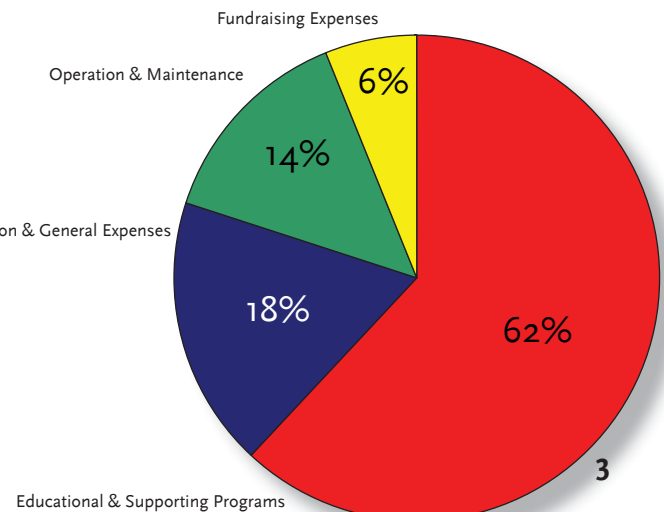

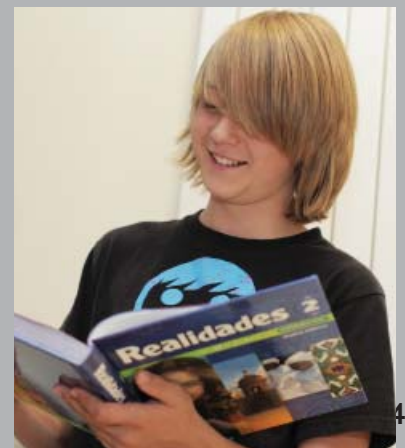

INTERNATIONAL UNDERSTANDING
THANKS TO DONATIONS**

Thanks to our donors, Long Trail School launched an International Excursion Program. The entire tenth grade class went to Germany and reinforced the school's commitment to international experience at a key time in the students' lives and in their high school curriculum.

"The generosity of the Vermont Community Foundation, along with the recent gifts of other thoughtful donors, allowed us to deliver on our promise to expand the horizons of Long Trail students," commented Head of School Steven Dear. "Rarely can a school come through with such extraordinary experiential learning, and we are grateful for this opportunity. We feel obliged in this global society to educate students through travel like this."

The trip was part of an exchange created with the Freie Schule Anne Sophie in Kunzelsau, Germany, near Stuttgart. 24 German students from the school visited Long Trail in February, and all Long Trail sophomores visited their German peers in April. The Long Trail travelers learned utilitarian German and participated in seminars to explore the socio-economic and historical factors that have made Germany a pivotal economic power today.
